#### 1- What is the topic sentence of the second paragraph?

The measurements *foot* and *yard* developed based on average lengths of body parts.

#### 2- What is stated about the term foot as used by the Romans?

The measurement *foot* developed based on average lengths of body parts. As can be inferred from the name, the Romans used the term *foot* to describe the length of a man's foot: from the base of the heel to the tip of the big toe. Though not exactly an accurate measurement, due to the varying lengths of men's feet, a foot was a measurement that was easy to conceptualize and visualize by most people.

#### 3- What is a "knot" in the last paragraph?

The term 'knot' is a measurement of speed in oceans and seas, with one knot roughly equivalent to one nautical mile per hour. This measurement of speed comes from the days when sailors used a knotted rope to determine their speed while at sea. A rope was knotted at regular intervals and tossed overboard. The rope was let out as sand flowed through an hourglass. When the sand had passed through the hourglass, the speed of the boat was determined by counting the number of knots that had been let out.
